

## Level 3 Summary Accreditation Requirements

Effective March 2009

### 1. Level 3 Summary Assessment Requirements

- 1.1 Pass the ASC Advanced General Coaching Principles Course  
*Note: Candidate coaches can request Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) or Recognition of Current Competency (RCC) for this component from an approved service provider.*
- 1.2 Be deemed competent for the **practical coaching requirements** as set out in the Level 3 Training Program.  
*Note: This is to be co-jointly assessed by the National Coaching Manager (NCM), National Coach and Level 3 Assessors.*
- 1.3 Pass (85% minimum on all 4 sections) of the current Australian Rules Exam paper.
- 1.4 Pass the Australian Strength and Conditioning Association (ASCA) Level 1 Course.
- 1.5 Satisfactorily complete any Level 3 Workbook worksheets and / or tasks as set by the Level 3 Assessor or as deemed already competent via RPL/ RCC via a L3 Assessor.
- 1.6 Satisfactorily pass all Level 3 assessment assignments as follows:
  1. Unit 1.3 – Sports Science & Info Services & Systems – Annotated Article
  2. Unit 1.4 – Risk Management Plan
  3. Unit 4.1 - Teaching Skills and Styles
  4. Unit 5.1 – Long Term Planning
  5. Unit 6.1.1 – Mental Skills Training
  6. Unit 6.2.2 Part 3 – Tactical Analysis
  7. Unit 6.2.3 Part 3 – Drills and Routines
  8. Unit 6.3.3 – Flexibility Assessment
  9. Unit 7.1 – Nutritional Requirements



- Note : These L3 assessment assignments can be completed via a range of assessment options according to preferred learning styles:
- a. a written assignment with guidelines provided
  - b. a written submission claiming RPL or RCC
  - c. a verbal response via an interview
  - d. a verbal response via a “hot-seat”

## **Section 4.2.2: Summary Administrative Requirements**

- 2.1 Once all Level 3 assessment requirements have been satisfied, a Level 3 candidate coach must provide the Level 3 Assessor with:
- a. a signed Squash Australia Coaches Code of Behaviour and Agreement Form.
  - b. payment of the Registration Fee of \$13
  - c. evidence of current and adequate professional indemnity and public liability insurance cover via one of the following 3 options:
    - i) Membership of the PSCAA (Inc)
    - ii) Join SACS
    - iii) obtain privately
- 2.2 An option is that coaches can choose to sign the Protective Eyewear Indemnity and Waiver form and provide this to the Level 3 Assessor.

Note: All these requirements must be submitted by the L3 Assessor to the National Coaching Manager (NCM) for checking and approval.

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
